WHAT IS THE GRI DESIGNATION?

The Ohio REALTOR® Institute (GRI) Program is designed to enhance your knowledge of real estate marketing and teach you skills that will set you apart from the competition.

HOW DO I EARN THE DESIGNATION?

The program consists of three courses, (30-hours each) which can be taken in any sequence, and are designed to meet the needs of both the experienced and inexperienced.

Note: To keep your designation goal in focus, the National Association of REALTORS® recommends completion of all three courses within five years.

HOW WILL I BENEFIT FROM EARNING MY GRI?

When you obtain the GRI Designation, you will earn one of the industry's most respected and prestigious professional designations. In today's business environment you need more than just motivation and initiative to succeed – you need the *GRI Advantage!*

CAN I TAKE THE COURSES OUT OF SEQUENCE?

“ Modular Format ”

You can take any GRI Course in any combination of individual days – take it one-day at a time or two-days at a time – You choose the format! The exam will be given on the last day, upon completion of all four days.

CAN I GET CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT?

Each GRI Course is approved by the Ohio Division of Real Estate for 30-hours of Continuing Education credit. GRI-100 includes Core Law, Civil Rights and Ethics, and GRI-300 includes Core Law as required by the Ohio Division of Real Estate for license renewal. This is a great way to earn your Continuing Education credits while working on your *GRI Designation!*

While all the courses are open to anyone, the right to use the GRI Designation is limited to those who maintain membership in the Local, State, and
